

In the summer of 2023, Full Plates awarded a total of \$495,635 to 60 grantees through 3 grant programs:

- Summer Meals Grant: Supports Summer Food Service Program sponsors with direct expenses related to providing meals to kids in their community.
- Summer Meals for Asylum Seekers Grant: Funds direct expenses related to increasing access to food for asylum-seeking kids and families who are unhoused or in temporary housing during the summer of 2023.
- Summer Innovation Pilot: Supports innovative pilot projects in rural communities with the goal of increasing household access to food and other critical resources and services.
